**Objectives**

The Workshop aims to provide an opportunity to discuss on hydrometeorological studies and water resources studies for Thailand and Southeast Asia related with **GEWEX** Asian Monsoon Experiment (**GAME**) – Tropics (**GAME-T**). Since **GAME** has just entered its 2nd phase of synthetic analysis and modeling, the Workshop will play a role as a kick-off meeting of the new stage.

A major part of the Workshop may be devoted to the presentations of synthetic research results obtained through the fruitful GAME-T campaigns. Another part will be arranged for every kind of general presentations which will enlarge our knowledge and perspective for our extended collaborations in the future.

Many participants in Asian countries, and other countries, interested in research related to the above topics, are expected to contribute to the Workshop.



## Tentative Schedule of the Workshop

- 29th-30th October
  - Presentations on hydrometeorological and water resources studies, which can be related with GAME-Tropics, will be provided.
  - Future plans will be discussed as well.

    - \* Climatology over Southeast Asia
    - \* Water resources in Southeast Asia
    - \* Remote sensing for hydro-meteorological applications
    - \* Analysis of atmospheric observation for hydrometeorology
    - \* Radar rainfall observation and analysis
    - \* Hydrological observation and water balance studies
    - \* Radiation and aerosols over Southeast Asia
    - \* Hydrological modeling and flood modeling
    - \* Atmospheric modeling and climate modeling
    - \* Water, society, and management
    - \* GPS observation of precipitable water
    - \* Stable isotope in hydrological cycles
    - \* Land use and hydrological cycles
    - \* Others
  - 15-minute presentation and 10-minute discussion will be arranged for each speaker.
- 31st October
  - A half day excursion is planned for surveying the hydrological situations around Chiang Rai.
- 1st November (not the Workshop itself)
  - It is planned to have a full-day special seminar with lecture series **in Bangkok**. The seminar is not included in the Workshop, but is for young and/or important scientists, engineers, water managers and public officers who are not able to leave Bangkok.
