2003 International Symposium on the Climate System of Asian Monsoon and its Interaction with Society

Objectives

The **GEWEX** Asian Monsoon Experiment (**GAME**) – Tropics (**GAME-T**) has been holding workshops approximately once a year to discuss about hydrological, meteorological and climatological studies for Southeast Asia. An important target has been the water resources management of the Chao Phraya river basin in Thailand with the better scientific knowledge of monsoon hydro-climate. The first phase of **GAME-T** successfully finished, and the second phase, particularly for intensive thinking and analysis, is in progress. In the recent workshops of **GAME-T**, the importance of the interaction between monsoon hydrometeorology and social studies is realized. For example, water management, agricultural management, flood prevention and global warming adaptation need more knowledge both from natural sciences and social sciences. The Symposium aims to provide an opportunity to discuss the fruitful results of finished/ongoing hydro-meteorological research activities and the future plans of our extension and interactions.

Many participants are expected to contribute to the Symposium, as a successor of **GAME-T** workshop, which consists of some special workshops and ordinary sessions with posters and oral presentations.
