


## Call for Papers Dead Line for the Submission 30th November, 1994

Authors who wish to present a paper are kindly requested to submit an abstract before 30th November, 1994. One page comprehensive abstract in A4 or letter size paper should be typed single spaced in English. The paper title, author(s), complete name(s), their affiliations(s), full mailing address(es) must be included. An original copy of each abstract should be sent to the Conference Secretariat. Abstracts will be peer-reviewed before they are accepted. Further notification of acceptance together with the third circular will be sent to authors at the beginning of January, 1995. A volume of abstracts will be ready at the conference. Proceedings will also be published and be sent to all the participants after the conference. The authors are encouraged to bring their four pages of extended abstracts to the conference.

If the authors have not submitted the preliminary registration form yet, please complete the attached Preliminary Registration Form and mail it to the Conference Secretariat with the abstract.

- Energy and water cycles in Monsoon Asia
- Observational studies about regional water balance in Asia
- ullet Utilization of satellite remote sensing technique for atmospheric, hydrologic and oceanographic processes in  ${\sf GEWEX}/{\sf GAME}$
- Physical processes related to interannual variability of Asian monsoon: Ocean, snow, ice, permafrost and soil moisture
- Land-atmospheric interaction and the role of vegetation in hydrologic processes
- Macro-scale hydrological modelling, meso-scale atmospheric modelling and their coupling
- GCM studies and diagnostic studies of monsoon
- Seasonal prediction of rainfall and water resources in Monsoon Asia
- **GEWEX** strategy in Asia and international cooperations related to  ${\sf GEWEX}/{GAME}$



### Venue and Climate

The conference will be held in the Grand Jomtien Palace Hotel, which is located on a quiet part of Jomtien Beach, which is located south of Pattaya Beach. Pattaya is located on the east coast of the Gulf of Thailand. The weather in Pattaya during March is rather hot. The minimum temperature is from 24°C and the maximum could be 32°C. It is the end of dry season and rainfall is not expected. The ground surface is dried up and the sensible heat should be high.

### Travel and Passport

Pattaya is located 147 kilometers southeast of Bangkok and transportation from Bangkok Dom Muan Airport to the hotel will be arranged. Participants are advised to determine their individual requirements with respect to entering Thailand by consulting with their travel agent, carrier, or Thai Consulate.

### Registration Fee and Accommodation

With a volume of Abstracts and Proceedings:

Payment shall be made at the conference, by cash only. Rooms are available at the hotel. Room charge is approximately US\$ 55 per person per night, and major credit cards are acceptable at the hotel. Reservation form will be enclosed with the third circular.

The organizing committee will fund a limited number of delegates from developing countries for the exemption of registration fee and/or for the accommodation.
